

CancerCon 2024 Keynote Speaker Submission Guidelines

Keynote Addresses are a vital part of our General Sessions. We welcome educational, topic-based, TED-talk-style presentations, or personal narratives from members of the AYA community. The duration of Keynote Addresses is limited to a maximum of 25 minutes, with few exceptions.

1. Proposal Submission:

- Please submit your proposal through our <u>submission form</u>.
- Include a brief overview of your proposed Keynote Address, outlining key themes and takeaways.

2. Presentation Style:

- CancerCon has previously featured a diverse range of Keynote Speakers, including comedians, one-person shows, and interviews.
- We encourage innovative and engaging presentation styles that resonate with our audience.

3. Video Submission:

- Provide a link to a video of your presentation is required for consideration.
- Accepted video sources include footage from prior speaking events or self-recorded content.
- The review committee will only review the first 5-7 minutes of the video

4.. Biography Submission:

- A brief biography is required as part of the submission.
- Highlight relevant experiences, achievements, and expertise that make you an ideal fit for CancerCon.
- Bios should be 1500 characters or less

Submission Deadline:

• Proposals will be reviewed on a rolling basis, with a final submission deadline of May 30.

Review Process:

- Submissions will be reviewed on a rolling basis by our selection committee based on relevance, quality, and alignment with CancerCon's mission.
- Candidates moving on to the next round will be contacted to schedule a casual interview with CancerCon planning committee members.
- Final selections will be confirmed by mid-June 2024.
